May 19, 2019 - Heritage Day



The theme for United Methodist Church 2019 Heritage Day is "Bold Women, Audacious Faith." The Women's Foreign Missionary Society, the forerunner of United Methodist Women (UMW), was founded 150 years ago.

It was birthed in the struggle over important women's rights of the time, particularly for higher education and professional positions or women. The women were committed to "extend the Gospel to women by women." They financially supported young women in medical and teaching positions in foreign fields. As the society continued to evolve it also sought to meet the needs of women and children in urban areas and among the underprivileged in the nation. They ministered through the establishment of hospitals, clinics, orphanages and other social service programs for women and children, through the agency of female missionaries, teachers, physicians, and Bible readers. The UMW continues to be a strong force for mission within the church. Today UMW mission initiatives include providing opportunities for spiritual growth, equipping women and girls to be leaders, providing education, and working for justice through service and advocacy.
