This will continue a dialogue begun in an Intentional Faith Development session earlier in the year led by former Old North member, Roger Frick. All are invited to this study held 11:00 AM to Noon on October 6, 13 & 20 in the 3rd floor meeting room. While “we know racism is bad, and we want to be good,” this mental good/bad dichotomy in fact tends to keep us unaware of how racism actually works today and cuts off conversations that would help us grow. Several short videos will be shown and discussed to help us see this more clearly and, in light of that, make changes. Plan NOW to attend all three Sundays of this timely and riveting subject, led by Rev. Joe Easley.

COMING OCTOBER 27 - A FIELD TRIP!! Open to all! The Intentional Faith Development class has planned an exciting event for October 27 - a field trip and personal tour of Oak Hill Cemetery and Arboretum . Those of you who are familiar with this cemetery, located at 1400 E. Virginia Street in Evansville, may know that it was founded in 1853. What you may not know is that it has more that 70,000 interments, a Veteran's Memorial Plaza, and a Level II accredited arboretum. We will have a guided tour by Chris Cooke, Superintendent of City Cemeteries, who promises to keep his tour to one hour and stay on the flat areas of the cemetery grounds. We will leave Old North immediately after the 9:30 service and head directly to the cemetery We are planning for the tour to begin about 11:15.
