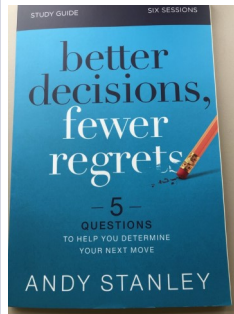
The Old North Fair Trade Market is open on Saturdays from 10:00 a.m. - 2:00 p.m. and on Sundays following the 9:30 worship service.
