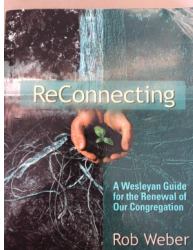

Have you seen our new roof?

All the church buildings have just received new roofs, prompted by the 30+ year-old sanctuary roof which had begun leaking. And, did you notice that we have not needed a Capital Fund Campaign to do this? The nearly \$70,000.00 project was completely funded by our ENDOWMENT FUND (Capital Improvement Fund) which has had many donations over its short 20+ year life.

This endowment fund is set up so that only the accumulated growth and interest may be used on church capital improvements. This ensures that the original donations stay in place to continue to grow for future needs of Old North.
