Fair Trade News: October is Fair Trade Month in the United States.

The Fair Trade Federation (fairtradefederation.org) designated October as Fair Trade Month in 2002 to encourage us all to look at how we can be conscious consumers – aware of how things are made, labor practices involved, how the artisans are paid, and how our environment is affected.

Twelve years ago – 12! – seven Old North women met to discuss opening a fair trade store as a mission of Old North UMC. It has been very rough the past three years, but the Fair Trade Market is still operating. We have continued to donate 25% of our profits to local (including Old North), national, and international missions. Through the Fair Trade Market we are able to support artisans around the world and those in need in Evansville, too.



Our mission statement: “to follow the lead of a just God in providing a foundation of economic stability and dignity for oppressed people through maximizing the power of fair trade, with any profits supporting the least, the last, and the lost.”

The goal of fair trade enterprises is to relieve abject poverty, to bring families up and out of the endless cycle. This often means children will go to school rather than work and families will experience stability.

We're so grateful for the continued support of the Old North Congregation.

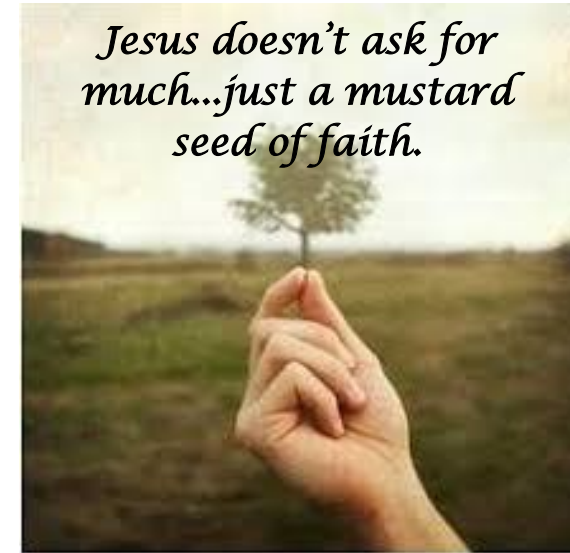
